A: Hosts are responsible for covering all dinner costs. However, hosts will receive an in-kind gift credit for documented dinner expenses (original receipts required). The in-kind gift amount can be allocated to an Emory school or designation chosen by the hosts. In the case of co-hosting, the credit can be split on the gift-in-kind form
